**Budget Detail and Narrative**

Rapid ID System by Data Works Plus .....\$3,155.00

This system allows for an instant check of suspects and offenders against a database of known offenders via electronic fingerprint capture in the field. This aids in the identification of suspects and prevents the use of false names or identifying information that would cause the expenditure of more law enforcement and court resources (e.g. bench warrants, investigation into true identity). This system would be an enhancement to the current units in use by the department and the infrastructure already in place.

Electronic Warrant Interface by Palatine Technology .....\$5,349.00

An initiative pressed by the Magistrate Court of Gwinnett County, this computer software and hardware system allows for teleconferencing with judges for obtaining search and arrest warrants. The system tracks and archives warrants and lowers transportation costs in allowing officers to obtain warrants without the need to drive to the location of a duty Magistrate.

Surveillance Equipment .....\$5,000.00

This equipment, such as covert and overt IP cameras, transmitters, audio enhancement equipment, and the various cabling to operate such, would enhance the abilities of the Crime Suppression Unit as it investigates narcotic and gang crimes within the city.

Crime Scene Processing Equipment .....\$4,248.00

The need to properly process and document a crime scene is crucial to any criminal prosecution. Basic equipment needs in this category would allow the department to equip an additional crime scene technician to improve coverage.
