&
CREDIT FRAUD NOTIFICATION LIST**

If you have been the victim of a financial identity theft, credit card fraud or if you have had your checkbook or identification stolen there are several things that you can do to limit the amount of damage that is done to your credit history.

You should immediately contact your bank and inform them of the theft or fraud. You should also contact all of your credit card companies to report the theft.

In addition you should contact the following agencies and inform them of the theft or fraud. You can then request that a Fraud Alert be placed in your credit records.
